

**ORDINANCE NO. 760**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XXVI, SECTION 13 OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF SOLOMON, KANSAS CONCERNING SANITARY SEWERAGE REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF SOLOMON, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SOLOMON, KANSAS:**

**SECTION ONE.** Article XXVI, Section 13 of the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Solomon, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 13 SANITARY SEWERAGE REQUIREMENTS:** All new construction of residential units, relocation of residential units, manufactured housing and all other buildings which would generate sewage, shall be connected to a public sewer system.


**SECTION TWO.** Existing Article XXVI, Section 13 of the Zoning Regulations of the City of Solomon, Kansas is hereby repealed.

**SECTION THREE.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:

Ordinance No. 760 Summary

On January 8th, 2024, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 760. The ordinance amends Article XXVI, Section 13 of the Zoning Regulations for the City of Solomon, Kansas concerning the sanitary sewerage requirements for new construction within the City of Solomon by requiring all new construction which would generate sewerage to connect to a public sewer system.
