2. REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE HEARING

The 2023 budget was prepared at \$540,945. This sets the mill levy at approximately 61.893. The revenue-neutral rate is 59.195. The revenue-neutral rate is the tax rate that will raise the same tax dollars as were raised in the prior year regardless of the change in property value. If a taxing entity believes their next year's budget will require more than what they spent in the current year, they need to approve a maximum mill levy prior to finalizing the budget.

There were no comments from the public

The city attorney prepared Resolution No. 2022-02 for the governing body to levy a property tax exceeding the revenue neutral rate of 59.195 mills. Motion by Kirby to adopt Resolution No. 2022-02, seconded by Hemmy, Roll Call Vote: Kirby – Yes, Bush – Yes, Duryea – Yes, Hemmy – Yes, Kohman - Yes
